Residential Visits

At Whitchurch, our aim is to provide an overnight residential experience for all children in KS2 from year 3 - 6 in each year of their time with us.

Children in year 3 will visit Youlbury Scout Camp in Oxfordshire to take part in a number of OAA activities over 2 days, with one night being spent away from home at the centre.

In years 4-6, the children will visit the following centres over a 3 year period:

Children in year 4 will spend 3 nights away from home at the centres while years 4 and 5 spend the week (4 nights) away from home.

We use our time at the centres to combine elements of outdoor and adventurous activities alongside geographical understanding of contrasting places. We have purposefully chosen both mountainous and coastal centres and also ensured that one year is not OAA focussed.

We are fortunate that the parents are supportive of these residentials and are willing to contribute towards the cost of doing this each year so it can (and has) become a sustainable part of our curriculum.
